Re: **PFMAC Expansion**

Dear All

The Archdiocese of Birmingham has, for a number of years been working on their long-term strategic vision to secure and protect the future of Catholic education. As part of this, all existing Catholic Academies and other Diocesan Schools are now becoming part of larger Multi Academy Companies. In the future, there will only be one MAC for the whole of Oxfordshire and as part of this vision, the DBMAC will join with the PFMAC. It is anticipated that the six schools within the DBMAC will join the five schools that currently form the PFMAC on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021.

As a consequence of this expansion, there will be some changes to the current centralisation of services and to the roles within the central team. These central team roles will be advertised over the coming term across both MACs, and the staff who have the skills and experience to undertake them are very welcome to apply for them. The upcoming changes will not involve any redundancies as the Directors are committed to retaining the skills of the current staff across the schools.
